Gospel Reflection

Dear brothers and sisters, in today’s Gospel, the risen Christ appears to His disciples by the Sea of Tiberias. After a long, fruitless night of fishing, the disciples hear a voice from the shore telling them to cast their net on the right side. They obey and suddenly the net is full to overflowing. In that moment of abundance, they recognize: “It is the Lord!”

This passage reminds us that when we labor without Christ, our efforts may feel empty, but when we listen to His voice and trust Him, even the ordinary becomes extraordinary. Jesus meets the disciples in their daily work, and He still meets us in our everyday lives.

After the meal, Jesus turns to Peter, the one who had denied Him three times, and gently asks: “Do you love me?” Not once, but three times, each time followed by a command: “Feed my sheep.” Jesus doesn’t shame Peter. He restores him with love and entrusts him with responsibility.

This Gospel is an invitation for all of us: to recognize Jesus in the ordinary, to trust His voice, and to respond to His call with love. No matter our past failures, Christ meets us with mercy and invites us to begin again.

Suy Niệm Tin Mừng

Anh chị em thân mến, trong bài Tin Mừng hôm nay, Chúa Giêsu phục sinh hiện ra với các môn đệ của Người bên bờ Biển Tiberias. Sau một đêm dài đánh cá mà không bắt được gì, các môn đệ nghe thấy một tiếng nói từ bờ bảo họ thả lưới bên phải thuyền. Họ vâng lời, và đột nhiên lưới đầy cá. Trong khoảnh khắc lưới đầy cá đó, họ nhận ra: “Đó là Chúa!”

Đoạn Tin Mừng này nhắc nhở chúng ta rằng khi chúng ta lao động mà không có Chúa Kitô, những nỗ lực của chúng ta có thể cảm thấy trống rỗng, nhưng khi chúng ta lắng nghe tiếng nói của Người và tin tưởng Người, ngay cả những điều bình thường cũng trở nên phi thường. Chúa Giêsu gặp gỡ các môn đệ trong công việc hàng ngày của họ, và Người vẫn gặp gỡ chúng ta trong cuộc sống hàng ngày của chúng ta.

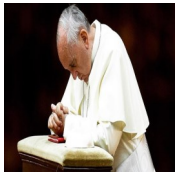
Sau bữa ăn, Chúa Giêsu quay sang Phêrô, người đã chối Thầy ba lần, và nhẹ nhàng hỏi: “Con có yêu Thầy không?” Không phải một lần, mà là ba lần, mỗi lần theo sau là một mệnh lệnh: “Hãy chăn dắt chiên của Thầy”. Chúa Giêsu không làm Phêrô xấu hổ. Người phục hồi ông bằng tình yêu và giao phó cho ông trách nhiệm.

Tin Mừng này là lời mời gọi dành cho tất cả chúng ta: nhận ra Chúa Giêsu trong những điều bình thường, tin tưởng và đáp lại tiếng gọi của Người bằng tình yêu. Bất kể những thất bại trong quá khứ của chúng ta, Chúa Kitô vẫn thương xót chúng ta và mời gọi chúng ta bắt đầu lại.
